

# God's Word on Homosexuality

This tract has been created to introduce those who are searching for truth set forth in God's word, and not based on the traditions of men and pagan religions.

It is to be understood that we are all God's creation and God will judge us all in the Day of Judgment. We are to be a watcher for one another and it is in this spirit that this tract is produced. There can be no doubt that God does not accept man lying with man or woman with woman this is not the natural union. We write this to call out those who are searching for truth, and although we do not accept homosexuality as an acceptable life style for a child of God, neither do we condone any bigotry or violence towards any of God's creation. We will look at the texts which so very clearly tell us God's view on this act.

*Leviticus 20:13 If a man also lie with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them.*

*Leviticus 18:22 Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it is abomination.*

*Romans 1:21-28*

*21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.*

*22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,*

*23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.*

*24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:*

*25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.*

*26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:*

*27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.*

*28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;*

These scriptures present both old and New Testament bringing us the same teaching, homosexuality is not acceptable to God.

*1 Corinthians 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,*

*Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrhah, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.*

The next scripture is the one I have seen used to show that David and Jonathan were lovers, but this scripture does not show this.

*2 Samuel 1:26 I am distressed for thee, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women.*

David has just lost his best friend; Jonathan would have been someone that David would have become very close with as a servant in King Saul's house. Love spoken of here is a love that transcends sexual desire it is a love that few people ever really feel. It is a sad world when this type of feeling for another human is compared to sexual emotions.

Jonathan and David were both family men, the following scripture introduces a son of Jonathan's.

*2 Samuel 9:6 Now when Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did reverence. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant!*

*2 Samuel 9:7 And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely shew thee kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake, and will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father; and thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.*

The call God makes to us is to set aside fleshly lust, and those things which serve the body and not the spirit. God said we were to multiply and man with man or woman with woman do not serve that command. Let us obey God and put away filthiness.
